

TRACTOR TRIVIAanswers:

1. The Farmall 400 replaced the Super M and Super MTA. Its optional hitch was called the Fast Hitch. In Canada it was called the Insta Hitch.
2. The tractor built in 1936 is the John Deere Model Y built at the Moline Wagon Works. Only about 25 were built; weight was 1,360 pounds; and price was \$532.50. All were recalled and scrapped. The Y was replaced by the Model 62 in 1937, which later became the Model L.
