Additional Fair tickets will be available for members if requested in advance for a reasonable price. The display will be an EDGE STA sponsored event. Fire extinguishers and wood blocks to prevent the tractor from rolling are required. It is also recommended that the battery cable be removed to prevent unauthorized people from starting your tractor. Please put your name on your fire extinguisher. Come and enjoy the fellowship and help promote our club and educate fair visitors about agriculture, antique tractors and restoration of farm equipment.

"Tractor Club" Standing Rules state the following;

FAIR DISPLAY:

1. Members shall attend 3 monthly meetings or events prior to fair to receive fair tickets.
2. To display tractors at the Fair, parades and displays a member must be in good standing.
3. Fair tickets will be distributed as follows:
 - a. Club member = 2 tickets
 - b. Bringing tractor/tractors to fair = 2 tickets
 - c. Attending Potluck = 2 tickets
 - d. Each 4 hour tractor watch per day = 1 ticket
